Starjump Assessment and Unlocking Literacy Program Developing Visual Spatial Thinking Kids

Starjump creates Self-awareness in children by Teaching them to Accept themselves for who they are while Recognizing their strengths. Through teaching them how to Juggle life's challenges using their strengths they will Uncover their skills and be adequately Motivated to achieve the Performance /dream that they are aiming for.

These assessments have been designed to identify any possible learning differences, or issues, and to highlight strengths in your child. Your child's situation will then be analysed and a formal written report will be completed.
